SCHEDULING ORDER

Based on the information available to the Court, the following scheduling order shall apply to this case unless modified by the Court. If no date is given below, the item is governed by the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure. The Court ORDERS that the following deadlines be met and actions taken by the parties, as follows:

- 1. <u>30 days from answer</u> **PARENTING SEMINAR.** Must be completed by this date if children are involved.
- 2. ______ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION (ADR). It is anticipated that the parties shall cooperate in an ADR procedure, under the terms and conditions ordered by the Court. Mediation will be held on this date at this time. You may contact the DRC if you wish to mediate <u>prior</u> to the designated date and time. The only way ADR can be completed after the above stated date is upon approval from the Court. Mediation <u>may not</u> be cancelled without approval of the Court. Should the parties agree to use a selected neutral for this case, they shall notify DRC and the Court within seven (7) days of naming a neutral of their choice. The case will proceed according to the scheduling order. The selected neutral shall report the outcome of the ADR procedure to the DRC and Court consistent with the provisions of the Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code Ann. Section 154.
- 3. <u>14 days prior to ADR</u> **INVENTORY AND APPRAISEMENT.** Spouses shall exchange a sworn inventory and appraisement by this date. A complete inventory shall be filed prior to the Mediation date.
- 4. <u>14 days prior to Trial</u> **DISPOSITION PROPOSALS.** Each party shall submit a proposed property division including property claimed or recognized as separate property to the Court and opposing counsel.
- 5.
 STATUS CONFERENCE. Parties need not attend <u>unless</u> they are Pro-Se. The Court will hear any Pre-Trial matters necessary to proceed. The Trial date will be determined on this day. Please have your calendars available.
- 6. <u>**To Be Set at SC above**</u> **TRIAL.** This case will be set for trial on the merit on this date.

If this case requires a Jury or involves substantial property division, or Child Custody contact the Court immediately.
